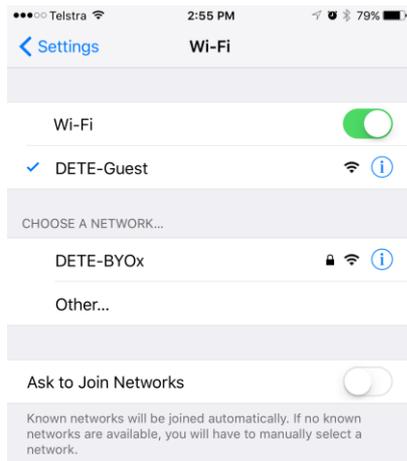

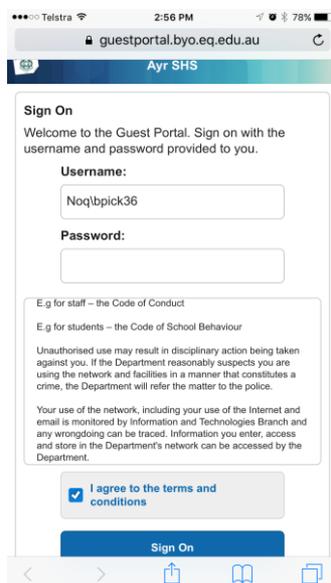
Purpose of Document

This document details how to onboard an iOS device to the schools BYOx infrastructure, and identifies issues that may arise, and provides solutions or workarounds when available.

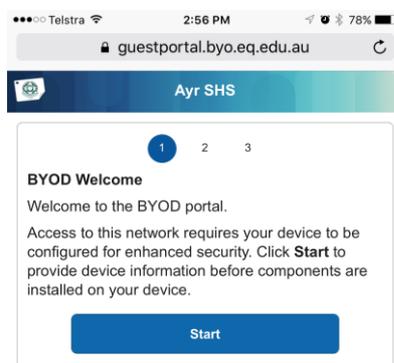
- 1) Connect to the DETE-Guest wireless network on your iOS device.



- 2) Attempt to navigate to any website in Safari. For example, <http://byox.eq.edu.au> or <http://abc.net.au>. You should be presented with the Guest Portal login page, as shown below.

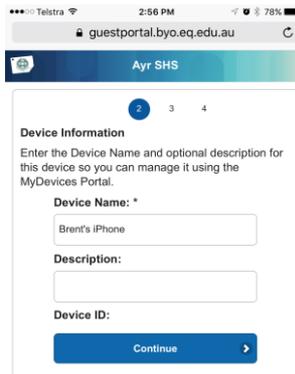


- 3) In the username box, enter your school username, prefixed by "noq". So, if your username is "blah123" enter "noq\blah123". Your password is the same as normal, and then tick "I agree to the terms and conditions".
- 4) You will be presented with the first step of the iOS onboarding process. Click "Start".

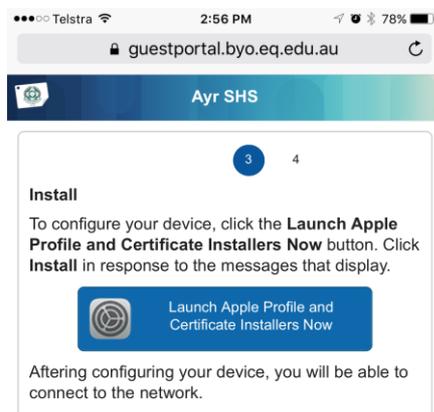


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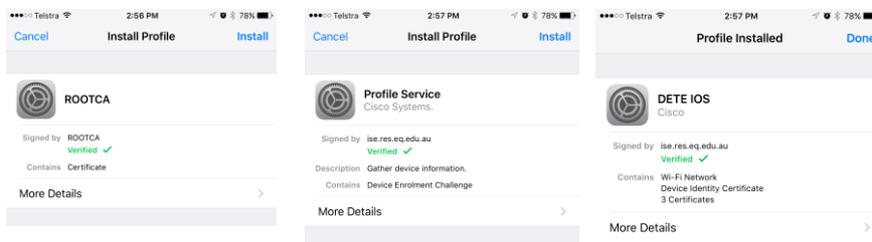
- 5) On the second step, enter a short name for your device which will uniquely identify it in the “My Devices” portal (<http://mydevices.byo.eq.edu.au>) – a description is not necessary.



- 6) On the third page, click “Launch Apple Profile and Certificate Installers” to install the required SSL certificates and profiles for your device to function with the schools network.



- 7) After clicking the button, several screens like the ones below will appear. Press “Install” on any requests that come up. An incomplete installation will require you to re-onboard your device.



- 8) After all the required profiles have completed installation, you will be put back into the Safari tab that you had open. The last stage of the process is simply to manually switch your wireless network to “DETE-BYOx”.
- 9) Attempt to navigate to a website such as <http://abc.net.au>, and you should be prompted for your username and password. If this works, you have successfully on boarded your device.

	<p>At this stage, there is no way for iOS devices to access network resources such as G drive, and printers. There are however various iOS apps available that may facilitate this, and tutorials may be provided in the future.</p>
	<p>It is recommended to download the Microsoft Office suite of apps to your iOS device to provide maximum functionality. It is also recommended to setup your school email account on the device as well to provide some ability to transfer files.</p>
