Purpose of Document

This document details the basic requirements (and recommended specifications) for students wishing to participate in the schools BYOx program.

In 2015, Ayr State High School has invested a significant amount of funds upgrading our network to support the departments brand-new BYOx Technical Solution (referred to as the “*Technical Solution*” in our documents). There are certain requirements that students must meet before being able to connect their devices to the BYOx network, which are detailed below.

Each student is entitled to connect three devices to the school’s network, but their primary day-to-day device must meet minimum requirements (except in situations where it disadvantages learning to a significant extent – such as with hearing or visually impaired students).

Secondary and tertiary devices do not need to meet the minimum requirements, but the school offers no support for them. An example of a secondary device might be something such as an iPod Touch with a smaller screen that may be used for extremely basic research. iPads which used to be considered secondary devices, are now allowed to be brought by students as their primary device for use in class – however, this is *recommended* only for students in years 7-9. It can be taken up by students in all year levels, however.

Students are required to return their BYOx Charter to the school in order to be able to onboard devices to the school network using the Technical Solution. This is so that the school can verify that their primary device meets the minimum requirements specified.

	Students and parents are not required to buy curriculum software at the point of purchase. The school provides Microsoft Office and the Adobe Creative Cloud suite free to all students (along with a plethora of other curriculum software).
