Success for All Students Policy

Expectations of Student Attendance

Ayr State High is committed to improving the attendance of all students in order to maximise the opportunities for success.

- Ayr State High School considers 95% attendance to be a benchmark of high quality attendance.
- Our expectation is all students meet 95% attendance.
- A minimum of 95% attendance means only 1 day absence in 20 school days or 1 day every 4 weeks and a maximum of 10 days absence per year.

The following circumstances will not be considered an absence. Consequences of Poor Attendance

Students who are not maintaining a 95% attendance (have more than 10 days absent) will not be considered to be meeting Ayr State High School expectations.
